1 An act to legalize the medicinal and limited recreational use of marijuana.

3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Section 1: There's already an agricultural industry in place for our state so adding another cash crop to
6 it wouldn't cost much, and would only increase the state's income. Money would also come from any
7 previous funds in place for experimental treatment by the Kentucky Cabinet of Health and Family
8 Services. In addition any funds previously going towards marijuana related incarcerations would now go
9 towards any costs that this bill would cause.

11 Section 2:

- 12 • First Offense: the privilege to purchase recreational marijuana is revoked for six months to and
- 13 a small fine of \$350
- 14 • Second Offense: the privilege to purchase recreational marijuana is revoked for one year and a
- 15 fine of \$1,000
- 16 • Third Offense: the privilege to purchase recreational marijuana is revoked permanently and with
- 17 a minimum jail sentence of six months

19 Section 3:

20 Listed above are the penalties for any of these actions: selling marijuana without a license, selling
21 marijuana to minors, underage use of marijuana, or being caught driving while intoxicated

23 Section 4:

24 This bill will go into effect six months after it has been passed
