1 An act to Generate Employment through the construction and Maintenance of renewable energy sources

3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Section 1: In an effort to create jobs and generate renewable energy in the Commonwealth of Kentucky
6 the state will sponsor the creation of windmills, the building of which will be undertaken by contractors
7 from the state of Kentucky who will then employ citizens of the state. Through this bill, previously
8 unemployed denizens will now not only have jobs but also an additional form of energy will produced
9 from the state that will benefit us for years to come.

11 Section 2: With other state programs already pressuring the state budget the Commonwealth will issue
12 state municipal bonds which investors will purchase to finance the bill. The project will be overseen by the
13 Kentucky Secretary of Energy who will decide oversee the staffing of contractors who will build the
14 sources of renewable energy and oversee the maintenance of said renewable energy sources.

16 Section 3: The windmills will pay themselves off in the long run and continue to generate free income and
17 any further expenditures will be the responsibility of the state after all windmills are have paid
18 themselves off.

20 Section 4: Sites for the windmills will be chosen after funds are appropriated and shortly thereafter
21 construction will begin, preferably on March 1st, 2018.
