- 1 An act to decrease the number of fire drills in all Kentucky public schools
- 2
- 3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
- 4
- 5 Section 1: The state of Kentucky currently requires a minimum of eleven fire drills per year in Kentucky
- 6 public schools. Each drill uses around five to fifteen minutes, depending on the size of the student and
- 7 faculty populations. Each year approximately one to three hours are spent outside during the drills. If the
- 8 number of required drills was lowered to only four, the time spent out of class would be reduced to
- 9 around 55 minutes to one hour every school year
- 10
- 11 Section 2: This bill will be enacted to help all public school systems and their students increase time in the
- 12 classroom.
- 13
- 14 Section 3: It is currently a requirement of all Kentucky public school systems to practice two fire drills in
- 15 the first month of the school year, and one every month after the first. This bill will require one fire drill
- 16 every nine weeks of the school year.

- 18 Section 4: This bill will be put into effect at the start of all 2017-2018 school year.
