- 1 An act to terminate teacher tenure in order to facilitate in the dismissal of ineffective teachers.

- 3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
- 4
- 5 Section 1: Terminate teacher tenure for the state of Kentucky.
- 6
- 7 Section 2: Transition from time based tenure to merit based yearly evaluations (45% Administration, 25%
- 8 student test scores, 15% peer review observations, 15% student reviews/surveys).
- 9
- 10 Section 3: No distinction will be made between tenure teachers and non-tenure teachers.
- 11
- 12 Section 4: Administration reserves the right to hire an assistant (retired administrator) for aiding in the
- 13 observations
- 14
- 15 Section 5: All teacher dismissals will be presented to the local board of education for approval.
- 16
- 17 Section 6: Teachers have a right to due process and can appeal their dismissal following the appeals
- 18 process established by the local board of education.
- 19
- 20 Section 7: This bill will go into effect July 1, 2020.
