1 An act to ban animal cruelty in cosmetics

3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

4
5 Section 1: Any testing using animals in the development of cosmetics will become illegal.

6
7 Section 2: The organization convicted shall be fined an amount of \$20,000 annually for the next five to
8 seven years.

10 Section 3: The fines will be issued by the Kentucky Department of Agriculture that already handles the
11 administration for animal related statutes such as the Animal Control Advisory Board.

13 Section 4: This bill will go into effect June 2017.
