An act to require all Kentucky public schools to include a recycling bin in each classroom.

## Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

Section 1: Currently, public schools in the Commonwealth are only encouraged to develop recycling programs. As a result, many Kentucky schools do not incorporate recycling bins in the classroom environment.

Section 2: This bill requires all Kentucky schools to include a paper recycling bin in all classrooms. This would decrease the amount of paper in landfills, conserve natural resources, and reduce greenhouse gas emissions.

Section 3: The state of Kentucky will provide the number of recycling bins needed for each school. The state will also provide a driver to transport recyclables to a management facility, and any other necessary funding.

Section 4: This bill will be enforced by the state of Kentucky.

Section 5: This law go into effect immediately after passage.
