1 An act to establish semi-annual dental clinics in all public schools.

3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Section 1: This bill will require that all public schools in the state of Kentucky establish semi-annual
6 dental examinations on school grounds.

7

8 Section 2: All students, grades k-12, will receive dental screenings and treatment within the school
9 setting, twice a year. It will be accessible to all students and staff at every school. Any additional
10 medical attention will require a recommendation to an off-site dental clinic.

12 Section 3: Third -year dental students will be administering the examinations but will be supervised by
13 their university professors. The funding will come from the University that the dental students attend. u
14 schools will be required to establish designed area that meets regulation standards and health codes in
15 order to complete examinations

16

17 Section 4: This bill will be effective beginning on August 1, 2017
