4	Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky
5	
6	Section 1: This bill will separate public and private schools in post season athletic due to the recruitment
7	of athletes in private schools.
8	
9	Section 2: Recruitment of athletes is against the KHSAA policy stated in bylaw 16.
10	
11	Section 3: Having two different divisions would allow schools across the state to compete for a
12	championship with athletes that live within their school district.
13	
14	Section 4: The way this law would be enforced is that when it comes to post season tournament time,
15	public schools and private schools would play in their own brackets. Public schools would play public
16	schools and private schools would play in their bracket giving everyone a fair chance at state
17	tournaments. There would be no cost involved in this bill.
18	
19	Section 5: This bill will take effect in the 2017–2018 school year
