1 An act to allow home schooled students to participate in public school sports.

3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Section 1: As of now, no home schooled students in the state of Kentucky can play in public school
6 sports. When this bill is passed, it will allow all students of Kentucky to participate in public school sports
7 and activities.

9 Section 2: There will be no cost to implement this bill into public schools.

11 Section 3: Any violations of this bill will result in:

- 13 • 1st Offense: The specific sport in violation will have a post season ban for that year AND/OR
 - 14 have 10% of funding cut for that season.
 - 15 • 2nd Offense: The school’s athletic department will be fined.
 - 16 • 3rd Offense: The specific sport in violation will be banned from all team activity for a single
 - 17 season.
 - 18 • 4th Offense: An investigation by the KHSAA will be held on the school in question.

19
20 Section 4: This bill will go into effect in the next annual school year.
