An act to encourage constable training and oversight

**Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

Section 1: This act requires constables in Kentucky to obtain a level of law enforcement training consistent with their law enforcement powers.

Section 2: Kentucky constables will be required to attend a minimum of 10 hours of study in the following areas of state-approved law enforcement training: firearm skills, criminal law, cultural diversity, emergency vehicle operations, and constitutional law.

Section 3: A constable advisory board would be established to meet every year with General Assembly members to review the training curriculum and assessment methods.

Section 4: This bill will go into effect January 1, 2018.
