- Section 1: This bill would require an additional 1.5¢-per-ounce tax on soft drinks (as defined by the Kentucky department of revenue) to be paid by the distributors of these soft drinks.
- Section 2: The revenue generated by the tax will go into a fund for Kentucky health education
- Section 3: This bill will go into effect on January 1, 2017
