5 6 7 8	Section 1: This bill would allow Peace Officers of city, county, and state jurisdictions to be protected under Kentucky's hate crime laws. Peace officers would be added to the list of requirements for a crime to be classified as a hate crime under KRS 532.031, that then a judge can consider sentencing.			
9 10	Section 2: This bill pertains to all KY citizens.			
11 12 13	Section 3: At the next Kentucky General Assembly on January 3, 2017 Kentucky senators and representatives will rewrite and ratify the wording of KRS 532.031 to include peace officers.			
14 15	Section 4: This bill would not require any funding.			
16 17	Section 5: There will be no penalty for this bill.			

Section 6: This bill will go into effect January 1, 2018.
