1                   An act to classify the rape of the intellectually disabled to Class A Rape.

3                   **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5   Section 1: The current sentencing for the rape of a person who is mentally handicapped is 1 to 5 years  
6 in a federal prison, which is a class D felony. This bill will change the sentencing to a Class A Rape, 20  
7 to 50 years in a federal prison.

9   Section 2: This bill will significantly increase the sentencing for the accused. This bill would include the  
10 act of raping someone who is generally mentally handicapped; has a lack of conceptual skills, social  
11 skills, and/or life skills; and has a below average intelligence.

13   Section 3: Any penalties or punishment that will be incurred for violating the proposed law that are  
14 already in effect. This would apply to the crime of forcing another person to have sexual intercourse  
15 with the offender against their will, against a person who is rendered temporarily incapable of  
16 appraising or controlling his or her conduct.

18   Section 4: This bill will be enforced by the State Government.

20   Section 5: The cost of this bill would be about \$40 per inmate; per day.

22   Section 6: This bill will go into effect on January 1st, 2017.

24   Section 7: Over 1,500 women get raped in Kentucky per year, and this bill will help to reduce the  
25 number of these by increasing the sentencing of the guilty part.
