1 An act to require all parents to complete a living will before the birth or adoption of a child to  
2 determine where their children should be placed in case of death or any other emergency.

3  
4 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5  
6 Section 1: This bill is to require families giving birth or adopting to complete a living will amongst other  
7 paper work before the child is born, giving information as to where the child should go in the event of  
8 an emergency.

10 Section 2: Over 7,000 children are in foster care in the state of Kentucky. This bill would significantly  
11 reduce that amount due to having a directive that states where children should go in case of an  
12 emergency during birth such as next of kin rather than straight into the foster care system.

13  
14 Section 3: This bill would be of little to no cost as it would only require little resources.

15  
16 Section 4: This bill will go into effect 30 days after passage.
