1                   An Act to Legalize Prostitution in Government regulated Brothels in Kentucky  
2

3                   **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**  
4

5   Section 1: This bill will legalize prostitution in government regulated brothels in Kentucky.  
6

7   Section 2: Due to the scarily inflated rates of abuse, mental and physical health issues, and murders  
8 associated with prostitution, this bill seeks to combat the violence against sex workers in order to  
9 protects our commonwealth's citizen. Through the legalization and regulation of contracts between  
10 workers and consumers, the government can protect workers that wish to provide services.  
11

12   Section 3: To combat the spread of disease, mandatory STI checkups will be taken bi monthly and paid  
13 for by the brothel. To protect from abusive customers, contact information and a contract will be  
14 signed before the service is provided. Any worker that feels they have been abused can go straight to  
15 the police and file a report.  
16

17   Section 4: A portion of all transaction taken place within the brothel would be deposited to the state  
18 government. The state would make money off income tax of sex workers. There is no cost to this bill,  
19 but a chance for Kentucky to increase revenue.  
20

21   Section 5: Workers providing services outside of the brothel would still be subject to previous laws  
22 regarding prostitution, pimping or pandering.  
23

24   Section 6: Individual counties will have the power to vote if they think brothels are right for their  
25 county.  
26

27   Section 7: This bill will go into effect March 10th 2017.
