1 An act to allow home-schooled students to participate in extracurricular activities within the school
2 district of their legal residence.
3

4 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

6 Section 1: This bill will require all public schools within the Commonwealth of Kentucky to offer all
7 home-schooled students an opportunity to participate in extracurricular activities, including team
8 sports, which are offered by the schools in the district in which the student lives.
9

10 Section 2: All home-schooled students who elect to participate in such activities must meet the same
11 general requirements, including any mandatory fees, as the traditionally schooled students in the
12 student's home district.
13

14 Section 3: In order to participate in school activities, home-schooled students must score at least in
15 the 30th percentile of the mandated state testing appropriate for their age.
16

17 Section 4: Home-schooled students who elect to participate in extracurricular activities must do so at
18 the school they would normally attend.
19

20 Section 5: The financial impact should be minimal and any increased cost would be paid for by the
21 school.
22

23 Section 6: This bill will go into effect beginning in the 2017-2018 school year.
