| 1 2 | An act to dissolve parental rights of mothers of babies born with drug dependencies. |

| 2 3 4 | Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky |
| 5 6 7 8 | Section 1: This bill will indefinitely dissolve the parental right of mothers who have babies born with drug dependencies. The mother may reclaim their rights once they have successfully completed an accredited rehabilitation program. |
| 9 10 11 | Section 2: The mother must be sober 90 days after completing rehab before she is able to regain her rights. She must pass a random drug test towards the 90 day period. |
| 12 13 14 | Section 3: The mother may visit the child during the 90 days after the rehab so that she is able to form a relationship with the child. |
| 15 16 17 | Section 4: A legal guardian will be appointed to make decisions for the child whether it be the father, a grandparent, etc. The legal guardian must pass a drug test before they are granted guardianship. |
| 18 19 20 | Section 5: If there is not a person willing or able to be the legal guardian, the baby will placed in the foster care system. |
| 21 22 | Section 6: This bill will be overseen by the Child Protective Services (CPS) and enforced by law enforcement services. |
| 23 24 25 | Section 7: This bill requires no funding. |
| 26 | Section 8: This bill will go into effect immediately after passage. |
