- 1                   An act to dissolve parental rights of mothers of babies born with drug dependencies.  
2
- 3                   **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**  
4
- 5   Section 1: This bill will indefinitely dissolve the parental right of mothers who have babies born with  
6   drug dependencies. The mother may reclaim their rights once they have successfully completed an  
7   accredited rehabilitation program.  
8
- 9   Section 2: The mother must be sober 90 days after completing rehab before she is able to regain her  
10   rights. She must pass a random drug test towards the 90 day period.  
11
- 12   Section 3: The mother may visit the child during the 90 days after the rehab so that she is able to form  
13   a relationship with the child.  
14
- 15   Section 4: A legal guardian will be appointed to make decisions for the child whether it be the father, a  
16   grandparent, etc. The legal guardian must pass a drug test before they are granted guardianship.  
17
- 18   Section 5: If there is not a person willing or able to be the legal guardian, the baby will placed in the  
19   foster care system.  
20
- 21   Section 6: This bill will be overseen by the Child Protective Services (CPS) and enforced by law  
22   enforcement services.  
23
- 24   Section 7: This bill requires no funding.  
25
- 26   Section 8: This bill will go into effect immediately after passage.
