1 An act to enact a None of the Above option on all Kentucky Ballots.

3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

4  
5 Section 1: This bill will enact a None of the Above (NOTA) option on Kentucky Primary Elections for  
6 Kentucky specific offices only. If the None of the Above option earns the majority vote then the  
7 participating political parties will provide a candidate. For elections in which parties don't provide a  
8 candidate, a new candidate will be selected to run for that office.

9  
10 Section 2: If the None of the Above option receives at least 51% of the votes, then a second primary  
11 election will take place 21 days after the initial election.

12  
13 Section 3: If, after 21 days, a new candidate has not registered to run for the office, the candidate in  
14 the initial election with the highest percentage of acquired votes will be elected.

15  
16 Section 4: During the second primary election, there will not be a None of the Above option on the  
17 ballot.

18  
19 Section 5: The only potential cost, which would be minimal and covered by the Secretary of State,  
20 would be additional paper ballots.

21  
22 Section 6: This bill will be enacted January 1, 2017.
