1 An act to increase infrastructure road projects in Kentucky

3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Section 1: This bill proposes that we increase the state budget allocated to road construction and
6 maintenance in the 2017-18 fiscal year. We propose a budgetary increase of \$40 million dollars to
7 the road system.

9 Section 2: The proposed spending increases would come from the general funds allocated tobacco
10 settlement fund, at no increase to the taxpayer, this would lower the the tobacco settlement fund
11 approximately \$50 million dollars.

13 Section 3: The proposed budgetary increases would be used to improve the quality of roads and
14 infrastructure statewide, such as expanding and adding railing to rural roads, and larger construction
15 projects as seen to be needed by the Department of Transportation.

17 Section 4: This budgetary increase shall be guaranteed until safety construction and maintenance has
18 been completed on all rural roads. This will prevent rushed construction and the safety and economic
19 security of citizens of Kentucky.
