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- 1                    An act to add a cyberbullying curriculum to all Kentucky middle schools.
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- 3                    **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
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- 5    Section 1: This bill will add cyberbullying to the technology or guidance class curriculum for students in
- 6    grades 6 through 8 for both public and private schools.
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- 8    Section 2: The 6-10 week cyberbullying curriculum would include topics such as defining cyberbullying,
- 9    what to do if you are cyberbullied, and the impact of cyberbullying.
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- 11   Section 3: The school will have to provide proof (such as lesson plans, principal observations, etc.) to
- 12   the Kentucky State Board of Education that the class is being taught.
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- 14   Section 4: If the cyberbullying curriculum is not followed, the school will be fined \$1000.00 as a first
- 15   offense. If there is a second offense, the fine will be double to \$2000.00 and in addition, a Kentucky
- 16   State Board of Education official will be brought in to teach the class.

- 18   Section 5: The cost to create the curriculum and train the teachers will be about \$10,000-\$20,000 and
- 19   will come out of the Kentucky School Board of Education budget. This cost will be a one time fee.
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- 21   Section 6: This bill will go into effect for the 2019-2020 school year to allow time for the curriculum
- 22   to be created and teachers to be trained to teach the curriculum.
