- 1 An act to allow Kentucky governors to run two non-consecutive terms in the Commonwealth of
2 Kentucky.

- 4 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

- 6 Section 1: Kentucky Constitution Section Seventy-One (71) states the Governor shall be ineligible for
7 the succeeding four (4) years after the expiration of any second consecutive term for which he shall be
8 elected. This is needed in Kentucky because whether or not your terms are consecutive is irrelevant to
9 the service of our commonwealth. This will help Kentucky because it will allow Kentucky leadership that
10 is more experienced in office.

- 12 Section 2: This law will apply to the previous and current governor(s) of the Commonwealth of
13 Kentucky.

- 15 Section 3: Future governors would be able to serve two nonconsecutive terms of four (4) years. This bill
16 is not changing the total of two four-year terms which is eight (8) years total.

- 18 Section 4: Consecutive means to follow continuously. Current governors are allowed to serve two
19 consecutive four-year terms.

- 21 Section 6: This bill will have no cost.

- 23 Section 7: This law will be enforced by the Kentucky Board of Elections.

- 25 Section 8: This bill will go into effect the next election year after passage.
