- 1 An act to protect animals from extreme weather conditions.

- 3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
- 4
- 5 Section 1: When pets (specifically dogs) are walked on pavement during extreme weather conditions
- 6 their paws are subject to burns and further physical damage.
- 7
- 8 Section 2: During extreme conditions (excessive heat/ extreme cold when salt has been applied) the
- 9 animal may walk on grass, but not pavement or salt covered roadways. Should the pet owner disregard
- 10 these laws a citation will be issued. The person in possession of the animal at the time of citation will
- 11 be held responsible and required to pay the fine. A quick test for pavement temperature can be taken
- 12 by placing the back of your hand on the ground, if it's too hot for you it's too hot for your dog.

- 14 Section 3: A first time offense would result in a warning. A second offense would result in a 25.00 fine.
- 15
- 16 Section 4: This law will go into effect 30 days after passing.
