An act to ensure the safety of boat docks and marinas by establishing minimum electrical standards, warning alarms, and penalties for violations.

## Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

SECTION 1. Kentucky Revised Statutes (KRS), Chapter 235, is amended to add an additional subchapter as KRS 235.231:

235.231. Title. Boat Dock and Marina Safety Law.

235.231 (a). Warning Device.

(1) Every dock or marina owner or operator shall install an approved in-water electrical monitor that produces a visual and audible alarm when electrical voltage is detected in the areas adjacent to the Boat Dock or Marina.

235.231 (b). Implementation

(1) Kentucky Department of Fish and Wildlife Resources (DFW) shall develop an inspection program and Inspections for electrical safety shall be done every 2 years by the DFW, and the DFW shall have the right to charge a fee as determined by the agency, and shall furnish an inspection sticker indicating compliance with this statute.

235.231 (d) Penalty.

- (1)(A) For a first offense, a person shall be issued a warning citation.
- (2)(A) For a second or subsequent offense a person is guilty of a violation and shall be fined fifty dollars (\$500.00).
- (b) A person who pleads guilty or is found guilty of a violation of KRS 235.231, that results in the injury of a person, is guilty of a Class A misdemeanor.
- 28 (c) A person who pleads guilty or nolo contendere to or is found guilty of a violation of I KRS
- 29 235.231, that results in the death of a person, is guilty of a Class D Felony.
