1 An act to require all schools to have emergency training programs for all teachers.
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3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
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5 Section 1: This program will be used to certify all teachers in managing emergency situation, such as if
6 a child needs to be restrained or contained.
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8 Section 2: This bill would require all teachers to attend yearly classes for training for emergency
9 situations.
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11 Section 3: Any violations would require the school system to pay a fine of up to \$5,000.00.
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13 Section 4: This bill will help the teachers to know what to do if a situation were to arise and how to
14 control it legally.

16 Section 5: The classes will consist of drills to learn how to restrain a student in a safe and legal
17 manner. Teachers will also learn how to deal with a student trying to harm another student. We hope
18 to improve the safety of all teachers and students in the school environment.
