1 An act to legalize medical cannabis for personal use in the state of Kentucky.

3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Section 1: This bill will legalize the personal use of medical cannabis. Cannabis is only 40% extract from the
6 plant, but still has the calming qualities needed to treat Cancer, Epilepsy, AIDS, Hepatitis, etc. Since there are
7 over 170 different symptoms that can be treated by medical marijuana, it can mean the difference between
8 your family member or friend's life. Without this vital medication, hundreds of people in Kentucky can live
9 another day, suffering through the pain other medications do not provide.

11 Section 2: The state government is responsible for controlling who can obtain the substance on a personal
12 level. They will also manage if it will be an over-the-counter drug or not, and will be prescribed in a necessary
13 amount from a doctor. In order for a doctor to prescribe the medical cannabis, they must be licensed.

15 Section 3: While the plant itself causes rapid heartbeat, disorientation, lack of physical coordination, and
16 depression or anxiety; the medical version has not been known to cause any of these.

17
18 Section 4: For anyone caught misusing the drug prescribed to them...

19 * 1st offense: 300 dollar fine, cancellation of prescription.

20 * 2nd offense: Jail time decided by a local court, further cancellation of prescription.

21 For anyone caught trafficking the drug will be...

22 * 1st offense: Jail time for both the dealer and the recipient of the trafficked drug.

23 For anyone that prescribes the wrong dosage will be...

24 * 1st offense: Jail time for the doctor and will have his license revoked.

26 Section 5: There is no additional money needed from the state because it will just be purchased from the
27 individual in need of the medical cannabis.

29 Section 6: This bill will go into effect on January 1st, 2015.
