- 1 An act to require all public schools to extend the school day an hour to make up missed school days due to
2 weather.
3
- 4 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
5
- 6 Section 1: This bill will affect all types of public schools regardless of grades taught. Once the school exceeds
7 the approved calendar for make-up days, they will be required to extend the school day by at least 1 hour.
8 The hour can be added on before or after the usual school time or both. This decision will be left up to the
9 local board of education.

- 11 Section 2: It is a KY law that the minimum school term is 180 days and the school must have at least 1062
12 instructional hours. This law would allow schools to still meet the 1062 required hours but not have to meet
13 the 180 days.

- 15 Section 3: After March 1st if another cancellation of school happens, the schools can no longer extend the
16 school day an hour to make up the cancellation but must add days instead. Additionally, the school can make
17 up to 7 days with this system. Once they surpass this limit, they have to add on days as well.

- 19 Section 4: The KY department of education (KDE), KY board of education (KBE) and local school boards will
20 have the duty of enforcing this law.
21
- 22 Section 5: This law will require no funding.

- 24 Section 6: This bill will go into effect for the 2016-2017 school year.
