1 An act to subject all middle school students participating in extra curricular activities to a random drug test.  
2  
3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**  
4  
5 Section 1: This bill will require all public middle schools to give random drug tests to any students  
6 participating in extracurricular activities in hopes of lowering the number who are experimenting or doing  
7 drugs.  
8  
9 Section 2: Funding for this bill will be achieved within the first two weeks of an extracurricular activity. Each  
10 parent would be required to fill out a permission slip that allows for a random drug test and turn in a \$15  
11 check to cover the cost of it. If it is not completed within the first two weeks, the student will not be able to  
12 participate.  
13  
14 Section 3: If a student participates in a variety of activities, they will have to fill out a permission slip for  
15 each activity but will only need to pay the \$15 fee once per school year.

17 Section 4: If a student is currently receiving financial assistance through the free/reduced lunch program,  
18 they will not need to pay the \$15 fee. Each test will only cost \$14 so the extra \$1 will cover the students  
19 who cannot afford to pay.  
20  
21 Section 5: If a student fails the drug test on the first offense (within the 3 year time at the middle school),  
22 they will be suspended from all extra-curricular activities for a period of two months. Before returning to an  
23 extra-curricular activity, the student must have a random repeat drug test. On the second offense (within  
24 the 3 year period), the student would be suspended from all extra-curricular activities for the remainder of  
25 the year with a repeat drug test the following year prior to the start of another activity. On the third offense,  
26 the student would be suspended from all extra-curricular activities for the remainder of middle school and  
27 they must undergo drug counseling.  
28  
29 Section 6: This bill will go into effect for the 2015-2016 school year.
