1 An act to implement a policy that requires every public and private school employee a full-time registered
2 nurse.

3
4 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

6 Section 1: As of August 2014, there are public and private schools that do not have a certified nurse
7 providing services in their school, and each year more and more schools are cutting that position to balance
8 budgets.

9
10 Section 2: This bill strives to ensure that each school is staffed with a registered nurse, in order to meet the
11 medical needs of the students.

12
13 Section 3: In order to fully implement this bill all residents will be subject to a tax increase or decrease based
14 on annual income brackets. The tax percentage will be based on the following criteria:

16 Section 4: Each school district will fund the register nurses for their schools through tax money. Each nurse
17 will cost between \$40,000 to \$60,000, depending on the nurse's experience. Schools without a nurse will
18 not be able to operate.

20 Section 5: This bill will go into effect on January 1, 2015.
