- 1 An act to require all public facilities within the state of Kentucky to install a baby changing station.
- 2
- 3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
- 4
- 5 Section 1: As of October 2014, approximately 75% of public facilities in the Commonwealth Of Kentucky do
- 6 not provide a baby changing station to their patrons.
- 7
- 8 Section 2: This bill strives to ensure that patrons of facilities in the Commonwealth of Kentucky have a safe
- 9 and secure place to change the diaper of their children.
- 10
- 11 Section 3: All businesses are required to install a baby changing station in each of their restrooms that are
- 12 available to their customers and visitors.
- 13
- 14 Section 4: No funding will be needed to fund this bill. Each business will be responsible for installing the baby
- 15 changing station. Current health department checks will be used to ensure that this bill is not being violated.
- 16 If a violation occurs, businesses will be penalized on a health check. Plus, businesses will be fined \$2,500 per
- 17 infraction.

- 19 Section 5: This bill will go into effect on January 1, 2015.
