- 1                   An act to require individuals between the ages of 12 to 18 to acquire an ATV license.
- 2
- 3                   **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
- 4
- 5   Section 1: Every month nearly 400 citizens of Kentucky are injured due to ATV accidents. 60% of these
- 6   individuals are children ages 16 and younger. In addition, 25% of these children were unsupervised at the
- 7   time of their accident.
- 8
- 9   Section 2: This bill would restrict underage children from riding ATV's without proper licensing. Children ages
- 10   12 to 18 will be required to obtain a license prior to being able to operate ANY ATV.
- 11
- 12   Section 3: Guardians of individuals who do not ensure these individuals are properly licensed while operating
- 13   an ATV will be fined \$500 per unlicensed passenger.

- 15   Section 4: This bill will be funded using the profit gained from the fees paid for by the individuals applying for
- 16   an ATV license, as well as the fines given.
- 17
- 18   Section 5: This bill will go into effect on January 1, 2015.
