1 An act to require to require citizens on financial assistance to complete 6 hours of community service.

3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Section 1: According to www.dailykos.com, 800,000 Kentuckians are currently enrolled in S.N.A.P. or
6 Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program, otherwise known as food stamps. To receive food stamps the
7 only requirements is that households may have \$2000 in countable resources, such as a bank account, or
8 \$3250 in countable resources if at least one person is 60 or older, or disabled. There is an abundant
9 quantity of numerous financial assistance programs with similar requirements which includes: Kynect,
10 Medicaid, Department for Financial Institutions, Kentucky tax credits, Kentucky transitional programs, etc.

12 Section 2: By enacting this law we plan to achieve a better Kentucky. By accomplishing this bill the
13 community will exceed ordinary standards by the assistance it will receive by the community service citizens
14 on financial assistance will complete. Community service may include volunteering at: public schools, food
15 pantries, animal shelters, etc.

17 Section 3: This bill will be accomplished by having special service sheets. On this service sheet citizens must
18 have the signature of the persons who manage the organization where they have volunteered. The service
19 papers can be mailed or emailed to their financial aid office. Community service sheets will be due by the
20 first of the month. This will affect Kentucky's economy in a positive way.

22 Section 4: This will be enacted by April 15, 2015
