- 1 An act to require the unemployment offices to stop paying unemployment benefits after 9 weeks if the user
2 has not applied for a job.

- 4 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
5
- 6 Section 1: It will be required for the person interviewing the applicant/unemployment user to fill out a form
7 approving that the applicant applied appropriately. Then the interviewer will add their input on how much
8 effort the applicant/unemployment user put into the interview.
9
- 10 Section 2: The unemployment user will be required to turn in the interviewing form to the closest
11 unemployment office.

- 13 Section 3: If the unemployment user has not applied for a job(s) or turned in their 9 week form, the
14 unemployment user will receive notice (emails/telephone) and at the end of the 9 week period, the amount of
15 money being sent will be deducted.

- 17 Section 4: The unemployment user will still be receiving their money, as long as there is proof of any
18 applications and an effort to get a job.
19
- 20 Section 5: The bill will not be any extra cost to the government.
21
- 22 Section 6: This bill will be enforced by the unemployment offices.

- 24 Section 7: There will be no extra cost on the employees in the unemployment office.
