1 An act to require a driver's test every three years after the age of 75.
2
3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
4
5 Section 1: Upon driver's license renewal at or after age 75, the driver will be required to take and pass a
6 driving test. This testing must be repeated every three years to maintain the driver's license.

8 Section 2: This bill aims to increase road safety and to decrease accidents. Testing after age 75 will make
9 the roads safer by ensuring drivers can adequately handle a motor vehicle, much as the young drivers are
10 tested.

12 Section 3: The state has existing employees that conduct driver's written tests and road tests. If additional
13 personnel are needed to comply then the driving test fee of \$3.00 per test will be assessed to cover
14 additional personnel costs.

16 Section 4: This bill shall go into effect January 1st one year after passage.
