1           An act to allow one public school staff member per 500 students to carry a concealed firearm.  
2  
3                           **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5   Section 1: By arming school staff members, this would keep all students and staff in public schools safe from  
6   armed intruders.  
7  
8   Section 2: This bill will require that all public schools in the state of Kentucky have a certified staff member  
9   licensed to carry a concealed firearm. If a school does not comply with this law they will be required to pay  
10   for an annual salary for a resource officer.  
11  
12   Section 3: The cost of this bill would be relatively inexpensive. The costs that each school would incur would  
13   be for licenses, training, psychiatric evaluations, weapons, accessories and ammunition. The total cost per  
14   school to implement this bill would range between \$700-\$1,200.  
15  
16   Section 4: This bill will go into effect July, 2015.
