1 An act to require all schools in Kentucky to have an AED on site at every sporting event and practices.

3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Section 1: All middle and high schools in Kentucky are required to have an AED at practices and sporting
6 events.

8 Section 2: The assigned officials for each game will check for the AED.

9

10 Section 3: If the school does not have an AED on site, they will charged a fine of \$250.00. The school has
11 30 days to pay the fine. If they have payed the fine, but still haven't purchased an AED, the games will be
12 rescheduled to the opponents school.

14 Section 4: The second offense of the loss of home games. The athletes will still be able to compete but at a
15 different site with an AED.

16

17 Section 5: This bill will go into effect June 1st, 2015
