To our dearest friends and champions,

The 2022-2023 program year was a year of regrowth and rejuvenation for Kentucky YMCA Youth Association programming. We settled into our newest normal in a post-pandemic world, which was only made possible by the dedication and support of our staff, board, advisors, officers, and volunteers. In partnership with our community, we were able to provide robust programming for students from across the Commonwealth. We are happy to share some highlights below:

- <u>Student Y</u> Staff this year focused on new opportunities for student connection in an effort to close cultural gaps in understanding and enhance formative relationships for students from across the Commonwealth
- <u>Kentucky Youth Assembly</u> Program attendance grew by 56% this year, allowing more students to participate in a space where they can build skills like critical thinking and public speaking, while also broadening their worldview.
- <u>Character Development Programs (GFI/LTC)</u> Our leadership programs elevated belonging by providing safe spaces for complex conversations, relationship building, and goal setting.
- <u>Young Kentuckian Advocacy Program</u> Students worked together to create action plans based on needs presented in their local community, specifically with the aim to drive impact in the focus area they were most passionate about.
- <u>Y-Corps</u> We were thrilled to bring back our original out of state experience, Service to the South. This service opportunity allows students to activate change in their local communities, state, and the southern part of the country.

In addition to our programming, we had an outstanding turnout for our Annual Campaign in 2022, raising over \$300,000 to support our continued work with teens throughout the Commonwealth through needs-based scholarships and general support.

We are continually grateful for your ongoing commitment to our organization and the students we support. Our work would not be possible without partners like you. We look forward to another year together!
