## Kentucky YMCA Youth Association Visitor Policy

### Civic Engagement Conferences

- *KYA & KUNA*
  - All visitors must visibly wear a KYMCA Visitor Lanyard at all times and return it upon departure.
  - Visitors must be at least 19 years of age. Anyone 18 years of age or younger (ie. fellow students, siblings, etc.) are permitted to visit during candidate speeches on the first night and closing session on the final day. These visitors must have a guardian accompany them and sign in as a visitor.
  - Visitors must remain with the school's advisor at all times.
  - Visitors are not permitted on sleeping room floors.
  - Visitors are not permitted before or after program curfew.
  - Visitors are not permitted during meal times, mandatory fun time, or free time unless approved by the Conference Director.

### Character Development Conferences

- *Go For It (GFI), Leadership Training Conference (LTC), Commonwealth Teen Advocates (CTA)*
  - Parents and guardians may attend only during scheduled parent/guardian meetings and student presentations.
  - Partners may visit only with prior approval and a scheduled visit.
- *Y-Corps:*
  - Partners may visit only during pre-approved times. Other visitors are not allowed.
